PWCA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

What is a PWCA Scholarship?

PWCA Scholarships provide financial assistance to high school seniors who exhibit excellence in a well-rounded educational and extracurricular program. The scholarships are made possible by the sponsorship of our corporate partners, generous donations of our countless supporters and from the dues paid by PIAA school districts annually. The scholarships are administered by the PWCA Scholarship Committee.

Who is eligible for a PWCA Scholarship?

Any current high school senior wrestler who is enrolled in a public or accredited private school in PA and has attained a 2.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) non-weighted based on a 4.0 scale for the three previous academic years. (Grades 9, 10 and 11). Applicants must also be planning to continue their education beyond high school in an accredited institution of higher education or a technical school.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The PWCA Scholarship Committee will consider the following for the purposes of awarding the \$1,000 scholarships.

A. Academic Achievement **25%** (GPA and Class Rank)

B. Athletic Achievement **25%**

C. Essay Contest **50%**

- 1a. The \$500 Scholarships are based solely on the essay.
2. May be used at any institution of recipient's choice. Education program must be designed to take one or more years to complete.
3. Recipients will be announced in June and receive a letter from the PWCA. A list of all winners will be sent to their guidance counselors. Non-recipients will not be notified.
4. All winners must submit a certificate of admission or letter of acceptance to the Scholarship Committee by July 1st. No letter, No Scholarship!
5. Scholarships can be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees and other academic costs, room and board.
6. A check will be sent to the individual upon receiving of receipts for books, tuition, lodging, computer etc. The check will be sent when the receipts are received by the PWCA.
7. If a recipient leaves the institution and there are PWCA Scholarship funds remaining, the institution shall return the balance to the PWCA
8. If a scholarship winner must delay their education for any reason, the scholarship will be held for up to two (2) years from the date of high school graduation.
9. The PWCA will be awarding up to four (4)- \$1,000 scholarships for the total application and four (4) - \$500 scholarships based only on essay content. The same person cannot win both.
10. All applications must be received by March 31st of the year in which they are awarded.
